- Totally proficient and comfortable with computers, modern media and technologies in general

We are looking for someone who is positive, curious, enthusiastic, loves to work, has a passion for this work, is helpful, flexible, discreet, well-travelled, comfortable with uncertainty, resourceful, problem solver, independent, and pleasant.

Unless the partner happens to be a teacher in humanities (English literature, essays, history and philosophy). And that the partner is available to be hired and travel with us as well ☺.
